



VISITATION TO NOC SURGERY CENTER

We strongly urge at least one person to stay at NOC Surgery Center during the patient's surgery.

Minors are required to always have someone with them at NOC Surgery Center.

If you must leave NOC Surgery Center, we will ask you to provide a phone number where you can be reached.

Visitors will be allowed to be with the patient after they are prepped for the operating room and waiting in the pre-op area.

Minors may have a parent with them in pre-op and post-op areas as soon as they are awake, with some discretion by the attending nurse.

If you are visiting a patient who had general anesthesia, a nurse will show you to a consultation room where the surgeon will talk with you immediately after surgery. Visitors will then be asked to wait until the patient is more awake. This may take longer than the surgeon consultation. Recovery time varies with each patient.

If you are here visiting a patient who had sedation only, you will be permitted to be with the patient immediately after surgery in the post-op area of NOC Surgery Center.
